- The Hampshire Council of Governments (Council) is a supporter of local green energy projects and a broker of “Solar Renewable Energy Credits” (SRECs).
- The brokering fee charged by the Council is 4%.
- Our brokering fee will be reinvested locally through the Council to help support more sustainability efforts in Western Massachusetts.
- The Council is officially registered with the Massachusetts Department of Energy Resources (DOER) as an approved SREC Aggregator.
- The Council is a local non-profit governmental organization whose purpose it is to solve local challenges through regional cooperation.
- The goal of the “Hampshire SREC Brokering Program” is to remove all the challenges that you as a home or business owner will encounter monitoring the SREC markets, while also assuring that you get top dollar for your SREC in what has become a complex and competitive SREC marketplace.
- The Council is offering the “Hampshire SREC Brokering Program” services to you as a new local PV solar owner.
- Local homes, businesses, farmers and municipalities which install solar PV arrays now have a local “registered” broker for their SRECs.
